Protocol for ACI Liaison Reports from B51 TSCs

August 19, 2020

1. ACI to make request to B51 TC Executive, including CSA staff per Directives SDP 2.1 Clause 10.2.1.
2. B51 TC Chair requests reports from TSC Chairs. (Note: TSC reports are also needed for Aug B51 TC meeting.)
3. B51 TC Executive checks the reports and consent given by CSA staff per Directives SDP 2.1 Clause 10.2.1.
4. B51 TC Executive assigned liaison (Mike Poehlmann) to review the reports and make a recommendation to the B51 TC Executive on content delivery to ACI.
5. B51 TC Executive's assigned liaison (Mike Poehlmann) to present the reports at the ACI meeting on behalf of the B51 TC.

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**Summary of TSC reports**

TSC Chairs will be providing their full reports to the B51 TC on Thursday 27 August 2020. The purpose of this liaison report is to highlight items the Executive Committee believes may be of particular interest to regulatory authorities with respect to subsequent adoption and implementation of the standard.

### **TSC on Clauses 4, 5, 8, 11 and Annexes D & J, Chair - Kim Greenwood**

- Approved
  - Addition of Clause F.12 Conformity assessment / Manufacturer's declaration of conformity including "Declaration of Conformity Registration of Fittings" form.
  - The Declaration of Conformity (DoC) may be used for registration of fittings under Clause 4.2 as an alternative to the Statutory Declaration referred to in Clause 4.2.2
  
- Pending approval
  - Adding reference to ISO 16528

→ Will the above be supported by the jurisdictions' legislation?

### **TSC on Clause 6, Chair - Cathy Turylo**

- Wood pellet burning boilers and EN303-5 standard: The SC is undertaking to understand the technical differences with respect to EN303-5 and the ASME code Section IV.

→ ACI made a consensus position on this subject as put forward to NPSAC. Short version – use the standards making process to establish a harmonized approach to the use of biomass boilers.

### **TSC on Clause 7, Chair - Djordje Srnic**

- RFC to harmonize CSA B51 clause 7.4.1.1 and HLW-101 of ASME BPV Section IV

→ Need to determine context of "harmonize" to determine potential conflicts with jurisdictions' legislation.

### **TSC on Clause 12, Chair – Kim Greenwood**

Question posed: Is it the intention of the technical committee that this standard should apply to process analyzers & process sample systems as described in IEC\TR 61831 On-line analyser systems – Guide to design and installation, and API 555 Process Analyzers – recommended practice?

→ Seems to be issue when manufacturer seeks design registration for process analyzer system comprising tubing, controls and the analyzers themselves.

### **TSC on French Translation, Chair - Myriam St-Georges**

- The translation provided by CSA editors required lots of rework by the review team to ensure correct French terminology and accuracy of requirements.
